- additional appendices.


For your convenience each of the above sections have been updated, reissued and serve to replace the corresponding section in the original filing of the Integrated Application in their entirety.

Also note that, in addition to the approvals sought by KNOC as identified in Volume 1, of the integrated application, KNOC also applies to AENV, pursuant to Section 49 of the *Water Act* (WA) for a licence to divert approximately 29 000 m<sup>3</sup>/yr from the storm water pond to process water.
